Thos. Nesmith, 90, Kellogg Resident, Dies Wednesday

KELLOGG (Special) — Thomas A. Nesmith, 90, of Kellogg, died early Wednesday.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Saturday from the Kellogg Christian church with the Rev. Herbert Miller, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in Our Silent City cemetery in Kellogg.

The son of James and Sarah Jane Wyatt Nesmith, he was born Oct. 26th, 1875, at Oxford, Iowa. He received his education in the schools of that community.

On Oct. 19th, 1901, he was united in marriage with Florence Mary Smith at Kellogg.

Before retirement, he was a plumbing contractor. He retired in 1948.

Mr. Nesmith was a member of the Kellogg Christian church and a 60-year member of Meridan Masonic Lodge No. 280, AF & AM, at Kellogg.
