

Dick Niester, 63, Dies of Stroke at Work in Illinois

Charles P. (Dick) Niester, 63, of 1803 Sixth avenue, Grinnell, died unexpectedly Wednesday while engaged in construction work at Joliet, Ill. Death was due to a cerebral hemorrhage.

Born Sept. 16, 1890, in Dillsboro, Ind., Niester came to Grinnell 35 years ago. A carpenter and contractor, he was completing work as a supervisor on a government building project at the time of his death and soon
