Amy W. Noll, 89, formerly of Grinnell, died Sunday evening at Parkwest Manor, State College, Pa.

Miss Noll was curator of the Iowa State Grand Army of the Republic (G.A.R.) room at the Statehouse in Des Moines from 1938 to 1953.

The daughter of Judge Thomas J. and Sarah Stuart Noll, she was born Nov. 18, 1883, at Grundy Center. She came with her family to Grinnell as a young girl and was graduated from Grinnell College with a B.A. degree in 1907.

She was a member of the McAllister Park Chapter No. 23 of the Order of Eastern Star in St. Paul, Minn., the Abigail Adams Chapter of the D.A.R. in Des Moines, the Aunt Becky Young Tent No. 6 of the D.U.V. in Des Moines, and the Plymouth Congregational Church in Des Moines. She also was an honorary member of the State Historical Society and past president of the Sons of Union Veterans.

Miss Noll was noted as an historical source in Civil War memorabilia. With her father she attended several G.A.R. reunions.

She was preceded in death by her father in 1943, her mother in 1939, and two brothers, Ashley and Warren Noll. Surviving are her sister, Mrs. Grace Noll Smith of Denver, Colo., and eight nephews and nieces, including Grant W. Smith of State College, Pa., and Thomas J. Smith of Inglewood, Colo.

Graveside services for Miss Noll will be held at 10 a.m. Friday at Hazelwood Cemetery on her parents' lot near the Civil War cannon, with the Rev. Newell E. Davis, pastor of the United Church of Christ-Congregational, officiating. Rites will be conducted by members of Aunt Diana Eiden Tent No. 22, D.U.V., Grinnell.
