

Edmond H. Norris

Edmond H. (Ned) Norris, 83, Long Prairie, Minn., formerly of Grinnell, died Tuesday, Jan. 24, in Long Prairie Memorial Hospital.

Graveside services will be held Saturday at 10 a. m. at Hazelwood Cemetery.

He was born in Grinnell Dec. 25, 1905, the son of Paul G. and Edna L. Hand Norris. In 1916 he moved to Minnesota and later attended the former Iowa State College at Ames. He founded the Norris and Norris Hatchery in Long Prairie in 1940 and managed the family business until retiring in 1974. He was a genealogist, a member of Alpha Tau Omega fraternity, the Connecticut Society and other organizations.

He was married Dec. 12, 1931, in Syracuse, N. Y., to Grace Bainbridge.
