

Lloyd Norris dies Nov. 8

Lloyd (Skip) Norris, 65, formerly of Grinnell, died of a heart attack Thursday, Nov. 8, near his home in Los Angeles, Calif.

The body was cremated and there was no ceremony.

He was born in Brooklyn, the son of Elzy and Harriet Norris. The family moved to Grinnell in 1923. He attended public schools here where he was active in musical productions. He had lived at various places, the

latest in Los Angeles where he managed a motel. Mr. Norris was a U.S. Army veteran, having participated in the Battle of the Bulge during World War II.
