## Clark Northcutt Rites Wednesday

Clark Earl Northcutt, 77, a lifetime resident of the Taintor area, died Monday at Mahaska hospital in Oskaloosa.

He was born Oct. 9, 1890, the son of Romaine and Anna L. Northcutt. He attended the area schools and farmed all his life within a one-mile radius of the Taintor area.

On Oct. 9, 1912, he married Susan Hull, who survives him. He was preceded in death by a son, Robert.

He is also survived by eight children—Mrs. Elyne DeJong of Taintor, Lowell Northcutt of Sully, Anna McDowell of Searsboro, Voyian Richards of Mondovi, Wis., Clark Northcutt Jr. of Oskaloosa, Gordon Northcutt of rural Lynnville, Vernon Northcutt of New Sharon, and Carl Northcutt of Lynnville. Also surviving are 21 grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren.

Services for Mr. Northcutt were conducted at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the New Sharon Methodist church, with the Rev. Mr. Jerry Brown officiating. Arrangements were made through the Hardin Funeral Home, and burial was in the New Sharon Friends cemetery.
