Albert Nutting, 88, Services Today; Lifelong Resident

Albert S. Nutting, 88, lifelong resident of Poweshiek county, died early Saturday morning at a local hospital.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Monday) from the James-Schafinske Funeral home with Dr. G. S. Bruiland, pastor of the Methodist church, officiating. Mrs. Dolph Miller officiating. Mrs. Dolph Miller was soloist and was accompanied by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner at the organ.

Pallbearers were Donald Nutting, Joe Neville, Gail Wheeler, George Bausman and Clair Hutcheson. Interment was in Ivy Hill cemetery at Malcom.

The son of Daniel W. and Ellen Gray Nutting, he was born June 23, 1871, in Poweshiek county. On Feb. 5, 1901, he was united in marriage with Josie Mary Wheeler at Grinnell. They celebrated their golden wedding with relatives in 1951.

They farmed southwest of Malcom for a number of years and moved to Grinnell in 1925. Mrs. Nutting died on Feb. 27, 1955.

Mr. Nutting was a member of the Methodist church and a former member of the Odd Fellows lodge and Knights of Pythias.

Survivors include one sister, Mrs. Cora Neville of Malcom and a number of nieces and nephews.

Besides his wife, he was preceded in death by four brothers—Fred, Chester, Will, and Clarence.
