

## Neal Osborn Rites Tuesday

Neal Osborn, 70, of Long Beach, Calif., formerly of Malcom, died Thursday, Oct. 26, at Long Beach.

The son of Frederick and Mildred Jane Biddle Osborn, he was born near Malcom. He attended the rural schools and Grinnell High School.

During World War I, Mr. Osborn enlisted in the U.S. Navy. Upon his discharge, he returned to farm near Malcom. In 1935 he went to Long Beach and worked in the Merchant Marine, sailing on tankers throughout the world. Upon retirement he returned to Long Beach to make his home.
