Albert J. Parker, 72, of Malcom died suddenly at his home Friday afternoon, Dec. 14.

The son of Joseph and Laura Foote Parker, he was born Dec. 10, 1901, at Earlville, Ill., and received his education in the rural schools of that community. On Feb. 20, 1928, he was married to Evelyn Cook at Malcom.

Mr. Parker was superintendent for the Green Construction Company of Des Moines, a road-construction firm. He worked in all the states in the central section of the United States, as well as in Canada. For the past three years he was employed by Grinnell Mutual Reinsurance Company.
