**Resident of Early  
Days Passes Away**

Mrs. Frances Langworthy Parks, a resident of Grinnell, in the early days, died Dec. 2, at the home of her daughter in Multnomah, Oregon, of age and general debility. Mrs. Parks was the widow of George Parks, son of Philo and Phoebe (Farnam) Parks, who resided in Grinnell after 1857. Her husband was a brother of the late John N. Parks and the late Mary D. Parks. Mr. and Mrs. Geo. Parks moved to the far west soon after their marriage and for some years resided in Lyle, Washington, where Mr. Parks died a number of years ago, and where Mrs. Parks' body was taken for burial. The children born to this union were Lattie, who died in young girlhood; Will, now living in Oxford, Kansas; Fred, in business in Portland, Oregon; George, in the Philippines; Carolyn, now Mrs. Douglas, of Multnomah, Oregon, at whose home her mother has after failing health, compelled her to leave her own little home in Multnomah last year, and Ella, Mrs. Horsford, who died some years ago. Grinnell friends will remember the children, as they came to Grinnell for their education and lived with their aunt, Miss Mary Parks, at the Parks home at 804 East street.
