Daniel Lee Parmley, 62, of Rte. 3, Grinnell died Monday, July 16, at Mercy Hospital Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Kenneth Wallace, pastor of the United Church of Christ-Congregational of Newburg, and the Rev.
