Jennie Koch Parsons, 91, of Kellogg died Monday, Nov. 22, at Heritage Manor Care Center in Newton.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the Kellogg United Methodist church, with burial in Chapel Hill Cemetery, Green Mountain.
