Services Held

Funeral services for Edward C. Patton, 82, who died Feb. 5 at Carpentersville, Ill., were held at 4 p.m. Tuesday at the family lot in Hazelwood Cemetery.

The Rev. Vernon L. Smith, pastor of the Calvary Baptist Church, officiated.

Mr. Patton received his education in the Grinnell schools and in 1912 moved to Chicago where he was employed by Sears Roebuck Co. as a buyer.
