Mrs. Lucreia Patton, a former resident of Grinnell, passed away Wednesday morning in Brooklyn, where she has been making her home with Mrs. Fred Williams. She was the widow of Dan Patton, who is buried in Hazelwood. Mrs. Patton formerly was housekeeper in the home of Clarence B. Evans, up to the time of Mr. Evans' death in October of 1933.

Mrs. Patton was born in Carmel, N. Y., and was a graduate of Vassar College. Her father, Benjamin Hopkins, was the owner of several sailing vessels and her husband, Mr. Patton, was a sea captain before coming to Grinnell to live.
