12-13 Wm. Paul Ended

William Paul, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Paul, was born January 1, 1845 at Dumining, County Antrim, Ireland, and died Dec. 14, 1924.

He came to America when twenty years of age and settled in Scott Co., Iowa. Later he lived on a farm near Newburg for many years. On Feb. 1, 1887 he was united in marriage to Jane McCosh. Six children were born to this union, all of whom survive him. He united with the Barrett Presbyterian church and was a member there while he resided in that community. After coming to Grinnell he united with the United Presbyterian church where he has been a member ever since.

Mr. Paul was frugal, industrious and kind. He had good health most of his life until his last illness. During the past few weeks he suffered greatly. He knew that the end was near and longed to go. He made arrangements for the funeral service. The songs were his favorites. Early Sabbath morning he passed away.

He leaves his wife and six children, Aenas E., Alfred J., Mamma Brandt, Margaret, Elsie Esler and Arthur H., and many relatives and friends to mourn his loss.

Funeral services conducted by Rev. V. W. Woodburn were held at the United Presbyterian church this afternoon and interment made at the Gilman Cemetery.
