Walter "Bo" Paulson, 85, of Kellogg died Monday, May 8, at Story City Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at Reese Funeral Chapel in Newton, with burial in Our Silent City Cemetery there.

Memorials in Mr. Paulson's name may be made to the Kellogg Historical Society.

The son of Paul and Anna Paulson, he was born Sept. 8, 1903, in Jasper County. He was a 1922 graduate of Kellogg High School and had spent most of his life in Kellogg. He was married to Lois Hum June 12, 1929, at Buffalo Center.

Mr. Paulson had been employed by Midwest Mfg. Co. for 25 years and was then self-employed as a carpenter, retiring in 1980.
