Mr. Pentzer dies in Ohio

Phillip Pentzer, 53, of Akron, Ohio, a native of Grinnell, died Monday, Sept. 27, at an Akron hospital.

The Funeral Mass was celebrated at 10 a.m. today at St. Vincent's Church in Akron. Burial was at Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington, Va.

Born in Grinnell, Mr. Pentzer had lived in Akron since 1971. He was graduated from Grinnell High School and entered the U.S. Air Force in 1950, serving in Korea and Vietnam. He retired after 20 years of service.

Mr. Pentzer owned and operated the Magic Inn

restaurant in Akron for 10 years. He was a member of the Vietnam Veterans of America, the Fraternal Order of Eagles, the Elks Club and St. Vincent's Church.
