**Former Resident,
Albert M. Pepon,
Succumbs Recently**

Word has been received here of the death Feb. 4 at Fargo, N. D., of Albert M. Pepon, 79, of Bordulac, N. D., a former Grinnell resident.

Funeral services were held at Holy Rosary Catholic church in Bordulac on Feb. 8. Interment was in Carrington cemetery.

Mr. Pepon was born in Grinnell on Dec. 16, 1883, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward E. Pepon. He was graduated from Grinnell high school with the class of 1900.

He moved to Bordulac as a young man where he was engaged in farming and operated grain elevators. For several years he was postmaster at Bordulac, retiring five years ago.

He married Loretta C. Foley on June 26, 1907.

Survivors include his widow; two daughters, Mrs. J. R. (Mary) Rusk, Jamestown, N. D.; Mrs. J. C. (Margaret) Rodgers, Brookfield, Ill.; three sons, Edward M. of Milwaukee, Wis., Benjamin M. of Tempe, Ariz., and R. J. of Royal Oak, Mich.; and 10 grandchildren.
