

## Marie Peterson, 84 (MARION)

Marie Pauline Peterson, 84, of Idaho Falls, died January 27, 1995, at her home following a lingering illness.

Memorial services were held at the Presbyterian Church in Idaho Falls. Burial was in Fielding Memorial Park.

Marie was born in Montezuma, Iowa, May 28, 1910, the daughter of May E. and Charles F. Ludeman. She graduated from schools in Montezuma and in 1932 she graduated from Iowa State University at Ames, Ia. On August 12, 1933, she married Marion Arthur Peterson of Ames. Because of work transfers, they lived in various locations including Los Angeles, Berkeley, Calif., Salt Lake City, Denver, Colo., and then returned to Salt Lake City for a time before settling in Idaho Falls in 1939. They wintered for two years in Mesa and Tucson, Ariz., and then for many years in Hemet, Calif.

An active member of the Presbyterian Church, she served as deaconess and Sunday School teacher. She served as a Cub Scout den mother, a leader in Brownie Girl Scouts, and a guardian in Jobs Daughters. She was a member of the Social Order of Beauceant, Daughters of the Nile, AA Chapter of P.E.O., and a 50-year member of Henrietta Chapter 21, Order of Eastern Star.

She was survived by her husband of Idaho Falls; children: Richard W. Peterson, Redlands, Calif.; Mrs. Tom (Janet) Lewis of Idaho Falls; and Thomas C. Peterson, Fort Collins, Colo.; and six grandchildren.
