

Martin Peterson Passes Away In Kellogg

Kellogg, Ia., Dec. 28, Special: Martin Peterson, 72, retired farmer, died at the home of his son, Louie Peterson, Thursday of last week at 9:50 p. m., following an extended illness from a malignant disease. Funeral services were held from the home Sunday afternoon at 2:00 p. m. and burial was made in the family lot in Our Silent City.

Mr. Peterson was born in Denmark January 27, 1862, and came to the United States in early manhood, locating in Illinois, then later moving to Mcaleon and after a period of residence there, moving to this vicinity.

He returned to his native land in 1884 and was united in marriage to Miss Bertha An laegre, ne Mason of that year, bringing his bride to this country.

In early life he was confirmed in the faith of the Lutheran church.

Mr. Peterson had crossed the ocean seven times during his life, returning last August from his last visit.

Surviving relatives include a daughter, Mrs. G. R. Poortinga of Osceola; a son, Louie, of this place; five grandchildren and one great grandchild. His wife preceded him in death August 25, 1933, and a daughter died 32 years ago.
