

Henry Pitman Dies In Albany, Oregon

S. Nelson has this morning brought us a notice of the death of Henry Pitman, which occurred at Albany, Oregon, May 1. Mr. Pitman was an old timer in Grinnell and was well known by practically all the old settlers. He was a meat cutter by trade and afterwards sold buggies for the Spaulding Mfg. Company. He went to Albany a number of years ago where his wife died in 1919, and was buried in Newburg, Ore. Since that time he has made his home with his son, Arthur, at Albany.

Mr. Pitman had been ill since October. His old friends remember that the last time he was here he was not in good health.

Burial was May 3, by the side of his wife at Newburg.
