C. Raymond Playle, 68, of 1203 West St., Grinnell, died early Monday at his home.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Daniel I. Ogata, pastor of the First United Presbyterian Church, officiating.
