Rites Said Wednesday For Kenneth Plum

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. yesterday (Wednesday) at Trinity Lutheran church near Malcom for Kenneth Plum, 38, of rural Tama, who was killed in a one-car accident on Highway 63 shortly before 8:30 p.m. Saturday.

Plum was killed when the pick-up truck he was driving went out of control and crashed into a bank of Richland Creek about four miles south of Tama.

Harrison Funeral Home in Tama was in charge of arrangements. Burial was in Dunbar cemetery.

Mr. Plum was born Nov. 30, 1929, in Poweshiek County, the son of William and Edna Plum. He was married to Carol Thornes of Dunbar.

Survivors include his widow and four children, Debi, Larry, Gregory and Alice; his mother, Mrs. Edna Plum of Toledo; eight brothers, Bill of Ottumwa, Milo of Marshalltown, Reynolds and Walter of Grinnell, Marion of Malcom, Lester of Toledo Heights, Max of Tama and Jim of Montour; three sisters, Judy of Marshalltown, Lois of Malcom and Donna of Toledo Heights.

Mr. Plum was preceded in death by his father, two brothers, John and Raymond and a sister, Dorothy.
