ROBERT LEMARS PLUM

Robert LeMars Plum was born Dec. 6, 1891 to Melinda Mable Plum and John Wesley Plum. He grew to young manhood on farms in and around Grinnell and attended rural schools near his home.

In 1918 he was called to service and served in the Army of his country until he was discharged that same year. After leaving the service, he returned home where he continued farming until he and his family moved to Grinnell in 1921, where he spent his remaining years at the present residence.

His principle occupation in life until recent years was the oil business. Later he was engaged in sign painting and saw work.

He was a member of the Methodist church. He took a great interest for the violin and various sports.
