Emma Cornelia Puls, daughter of J. Henry and Maria Louisa Hink, was born July 18, 1884, in Chester Township, Poweshiek County, Iowa.

On September 14, 1884 she was made a member of Trinity Lutheran Church by holy baptism. She was instructed in the Christian faith in this same church and on April 8, 1900, she was confirmed in this faith and made a participating member of the same congregation.
