## Perry E. Pyle, Former Malcom Teacher, Dies

Perry E. Pyle, 73, a former resident of Malcom, died Monday morning, May 3, at Granite City, Ill.

Memorial services were held on Wednesday, May 5, at Granite City, with burial in the Sunset Hills cemetery there.

Born near Malcom on Nov. 6, 1891, he graduated from Malcom high school in 1909 and from Grinnell College in 1914.

He served as a superintendent of schools in Iowa for 41 years. Six of those years were spent in the Malcom public schools.

After retirement, he moved to Granite City where he served as a substitute teacher in the local school system.

Survivors include his widow, Lulu; a son, Dr. Ronald E. Pyle of Granite City; a daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth Jennings of Des Moines; a sister, Dr. S. Idell Pyle of Cleveland, Ohio; a brother, W. A. Pyle of Altona, Ill.; six grandchildren and one great grandchild.
