Last Rites Said For Mrs. Renaud

Beulah Johnson Renaud, daughter of Henry and Melissa Charles Johnson and the widow of John H. Renaud, died Monday, Sept. 16, at the Mayflower Home in Grinnell.

Mrs. Renaud was born on a farm near Lynnville on March 20, 1884, and graduated from Lynnville high school. She later attended William Penn College in Oskaloosa.

On Feb. 17, 1909, Mrs. Renaud was united in marriage with John Henry Renaud and they farmed all of their married life before retiring to Grinnell in 1947. Mr. Renaud died in May of 1956, and since 1959 Mrs. Renaud had been a resident of Mayflower Home.

Mrs. Renaud had been active in church and community affairs until ill health limited her activities. She was a birthright member of the Society of Friends but upon moving to Grinnell became a member of the United Church of Christ-Congregational.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. George J. Soukup of Marietta, Ga.; one son, Donald J. Renaud of Rte. 3, Grinnell; one sister, Miss Olivia Johnson of the Mayflower Home; one brother, Leland Johnson of New Virginia; and five grandchildren — Mary and Richard Soukup of Marietta, Ga., Mrs. Dennis (Janet) Liston of Columbus, Ohio, Paul Renaud of Cedar Falls, and Joann Renaud.

Mrs. Renaud was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, three brothers, and two sisters.

Funeral services for Mrs. Renaud were held at 2 p.m. today (Thursday) at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with the Rev. Newel E. Davis officiating.

Mrs. R. J. Nash was organist. Pallbearers were Emmett Elder, Wayne Schwartz, Floyd A. Speas, Burnell Settle, Robert Johnson, and Hobert Z. Cammack.
