

Mrs. Eliza Renaud Dies In Lynnville

Lynnville, Ia., June 7, Special:
Eliza Ellen Stanley, daughter of
Michael and Lydia Jane Stanley,
was born in Wayne county, Indi-
ana, October 10, 1856, and passed
away at her home in Lynnville,
May 31, 1935, aged 78 years, 7
months and 21 days.

When she was three years of
age, she moved with her parents to
Iowa and spent her early girlhood
in and around Lynnville.

She graduated from Grinnell Col-
lege in the class of 1885, and for
some years taught school in this
vicinity.

On Dec. 30, 1891, she was united
in marriage to Rev. Charles Re-
naud of the Chester neighborhood.

To this union were born four
children, three of whom are still
living. In 1906 the family moved
to Lynnville, where she lived until
her death.

Her husband preceded her in
death on November 7, 1903, her
daughter Ethel on August 28, 1925,
her stepdaughter Lizzie on June
11, 1901 and her stepson Charles
on May 16, 1934.

She was a birthright member of
the Friends Church. For many
years she taught in the Sunday
school and took an active part in
the Women's Missionary Society.
She was also active in the W. C.
T. U. and in the Mary White Chap-
ter of the Eastern Star.

She was a devoted wife and mo-
ther, a good neighbor and a friend
of all.

O., Mrs. Leo B. Davis of Lynnville;
Stepchildren, Eugene of Grinnell,
Edward of Lynnville, Ben, of Des
