

## Ernest Renaud services today

Ernest W. Renaud, 55, of 1411 Third Ave., Grinnell, died suddenly Friday of an apparent heart attack while jogging on the Grinnell College outdoor athletic track.

Memorial services will be held at 3 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with John Lowenberg, a reader of the First Church of Christ, Scientist, Ottumwa, officiating. Following cremation, Mr. Renaud's ashes will be buried at Hazelwood Cemetery.

The son of Eugene and Myra Jane Sherman Renaud, he was born Sept. 1, 1923, at Searsboro. He attended Grinnell schools and was graduated from Grinnell High

School. During World War II, he served with the U.S. Navy.

On June 29, 1947, he was married to Frances Jeanne Thomas at Des Moines.

Mr. Renaud was employed by the former Strand Theater as a projectionist, by Arnold's Shoe Store, and by the George and Rolfe Hardware Store. In 1964, he began working as Grinnell College postmaster.

Survivors include his wife; three sons, Ronald L. Renaud and David L. Renaud, both of Grinnell, and Bruce L. Renaud of Dubuque; and three brothers, George of Springdale, Ark., Virgil of Mason City, and Carroll of Loudonville, N.Y.

He was preceded in death by his parents and four brothers.
