Alice Lee Renfrow, 91, of Chicago, formerly of Grinnell, died of cancer at her home Monday, March 10.

A memorial service will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, with burial in Hazelwood Cemetery. There will be no visitation.

She was born Jan. 19, 1906, at Red Wing, Minn., to Lee Augustus and Eva Pearl Craig Renfrow. The family moved to Grinnell where she was raised and graduated from Grinnell High School.
