Lifelong Jasper Resident Dies ^{H R}

Mrs. Roy (Edna C.) Rhodes, 90, a life-long resident of Jasper county, died Sunday morning at the County Home where she had lived the last two years. She was born on the Bleakney farm (now farmed by Louis Klemm, Jr.) near Kellogg and never lived more than two miles from that community.

Mrs. Rhodes was born on January 1, 1881, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Benjamin F. Bleakney. On January 1, 1907, she was married to Roy Rhodes, who died in 1967. Mrs. Rhodes was a member of the Kellogg Christian church, and a charter member of Glendale Grange, organized many years ago.

Services were held in Johnson Chapel, Newton, Tuesday, Aug. 31, with the Rev. Robert Gamble,

Kellogg, officiating. Interment was in Our Silent City.

Survivors include a number of nieces and nephews in the Newton and Kellogg area, and one nephew in Saskatchewan, Canada.
