Dorothy L. Richardson, 89, a resident of Friendship Manor for 13 years and formerly of rural Kellogg, died Thursday, Aug. 26, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

Graveside services were conducted Monday at Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg, with the Rev. Duane Skidmore of the Killduff United Methodist Church officiating. The Reese Funeral Home of Newton was in charge of arrangements.

She was the daughter of Edward L. and Edna M. Stieglitz Antle and was born Sept. 24, 1909, in Kellogg. She attended rural Jasper County schools and was a graduate of Kellogg High School. She also graduated from Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls.

She taught in rural Jasper County schools until her marriage to Ralph Richardson March 23, 1934. She then was a homemaker and farmed with her husband.

Mrs. Richardson was a member of the Kellogg United Methodist Church, the WSCS, Richland Grange, the Kellogg Garden Club and Home and Community Club. She served as Sunday school superintendent and teacher at her church.

Surviving are two sons, Earl of rural Killduff and Dale of Sterling, Ill.; one sister, Ruth Luse of Bentonville, Ark.; three grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.
