

Raymond Richman Rites Held Friday

Funeral services were held at the Presbyterian church Friday morning for Raymond Arthur Richman, 79, retired Brooklyn farmer who died at a Grinnell hospital March 22.

Rev. George Roquet had charge of the rites and burial was in the IOOF cemetery.
