

Wm. Ring, Long Time Resident Of Kellogg, Dies

Kellogg, Ia., Sept. 25. Special:

William Ring, 78, resident of the county for the past 60 years, died at St. Francis hospital in Grinnell Saturday afternoon, Sept. 11, at 1:30 o'clock, following an illness of several months' duration.

Funeral services were held Tuesday morning at the Sacred Heart church in Newton, with Father T. J. McCann in charge and burial was made in the Newton Catholic cemetery. The rosary was given Monday evening at 7 o'clock at the Murdoch funeral home.

Mr. Ring was born in Lynnville, July 2, 1856, and had spent his entire life in this county. At one time he was employed as doorkeeper at the Iowa State Legislature.

Surviving relatives include two brothers, Andy and Tom Ring of Newton, and a sister, Mrs. Mary Kelley of Colfax.
