Mrs. David Rivers Buried Monday

The funeral of Mrs. David Rivers was held Monday morning, Jan. 3, at the Steffy Funeral Home. Officiating at the services was the Rev. Howard Hayes. The organist was Mrs. K. W. Steffy.

Interment was in Jackson Township Cemetery with Ed Lester, Phil Evans, Earl Beach, Worth Belden, Harry Bunnell and Lyle McFerren serving as pallbearers.

Agnes, daughter of Mary and James W. Wood, was born Sept. 1, 1884, near Blue Point in Poweshiek County, and died in Sedalia, Mo., Friday, Dec. 31. She was 81.

She attended rural school and on March 6, 1910, she married David Rivers. To this union three children were born. They lived in Poweshiek County where Mr. Rivers engaged in farming. She was a member of the Blue Point Methodist Church, the Wisner Circle of the G.A.R. and the Midway Grange.

Mr. and Mrs. Rivers retired in 1959 and moved to Phoenix, Ariz. In 1960, Mrs. Rivers suffered a stroke from which she never fully recovered.

She is survived by her husband and two sons, Farrell, of Buckeye, Ariz., and Edward of Sedalia, Mo.; one daughter, Glema Jones of Davenport, Iowa; six grandchildren and four great-grandsons.
