

Rites Set for ^{H.R.} Mr. Robertson

~~Harry Eugene Robertson~~, 66, died Wednesday noon at Grinnell General Hospital, following an extended illness. He was born Jan. 8, 1906, at Malcom, the son of Thomas and Rosetta Robertson. He lived in Malcom most of his life. Mr. Robertson worked for the county for 37 years and was the Poweshiek County road foreman for about 25 years until he retired in 1971. He graduated from Malcom High School in 1924.

He was married to Blanche Agnes Wiese of Brooklyn Feb. 20, 1935. The couple had four children—Thomas Eugene Robertson of Newton, Mrs. Danny (Patricia) Slagle of Grinnell, Mrs. Murry (Barbara) Brown of Malcom, and Spec. 4 James Lynn Robertson, who is stationed at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., with the U.S. Army.

Mr. Robertson is survived by his wife; his four children; seven grandchildren, Ricky, Julie and Jodie Slagle, Rochell, Nina and Kristy Brown, and Christopher Robertson; his sister, Mrs. Claire (Opal) Meyer of Brooklyn; and his nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his father in 1933, his mother in 1951, and a sister and brother in infancy.

Funeral services for Mr. Robertson will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home, with the Rev. J. Eugene Young, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating.

Burial will be in Ivy Hill Cemetery, Malcom.
