Charles Frederick Rohr

Charles Frederick Rohr, son of the late Henry Rohr and wife Wilhelmina, nee Schroeder, was born in Sheridan township, Poweshiek County, Iowa, March 19, 1877.

As an infant he was baptized at Trinity Lutheran church and later received the rite of confirmation. When he was 7 years of age, his family moved to the farm which was to be his home for the remainder of his life.

On Feb. 26, 1908, he was united in holy matrimony at Trinity church with Miss Rosa Beck. Born to this union were one daughter and five sons.

Throughout all his days Mr. Rohr maintained a lively interest in his church. He served Trinity Lutheran several times as a member of the church council. He was also a member of the Brotherhood until his

him to attend or be active.

About three years ago Mr. Rohr became seriously ill and required extensive hospitalization. Since his return from the hospital he had been a semi-invalid.

On March 27 in his sleep he suffered a cerebral embolism, rendering him unconscious and leaving him paralyzed. He passed away peacefully about midnight Wednesday, March 31, 1954. He attained the age of 77 years and 12 days.

He leaves to mourn his departure his life's companion, Rosa; five sons, Erwin of Lynn, Mass.; Oscar of Portland, Ore.; Carl of Searsboro; John of Marenco; and Loring of Grinnell. His daughter, Henrietta, preceded him in death about a year ago.

He leaves also three sisters, Elizabeth of Grinnell, Mrs. Lena Bastian of Newburg, and Ella Hewitt of Austin, Minnesota; two brothers, John of Gilman and Chris of Centralia, Wash. One brother and one sister preceded Charles in death.

Also surviving are eight grandsons, besides many other relatives and a host of friends.

Funeral services were held Saturday, April 3, at Trinity Lutheran church with the Rev. G. C. Wiegand, pastor, in charge. Interment was in the Trinity Lutheran cemetery.
