

## James Roth services held

James D. Roth, 75, of Kellogg, who was associated with the Kellogg Savings Bank for 55 years, died Thursday at Skiff Memorial Hospital in Newton.

Funeral services were held at 9:30 a.m. Saturday at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Newton. The Kellogg and Sully Savings Banks were closed all day Saturday in memory of Mr. Roth.

The son of Hiram S. and Anna Brien Roth, he was born May 11, 1900, in Kellogg. He was married to Josephine Reed on April 18, 1931, in Des Moines. Mrs. Roth preceded him in death in 1932.
