Mrs. J. D. Roth died at the Iowa Lutheran hospital in Des Moines Friday afternoon at 1:00 o'clock following the birth of a son there Saturday, February 27. Funeral services were held at the Dunn Funeral Parlors in Des Moines Monday morning at 10:30 with Rev. C. S. Medbury, pastor of the Christian church, in charge, and burial was made in Glendale cemetery there.

Josephine Breed was born in Des Moines, December 4, 1907. She was graduated from the Cedar Rapids high school and Drake University where she was prominent in dramatic work and musical circles.

She appeared on the Chautauqua platform for two seasons as vocal soloist and served as instructor in English and music in the city school here for two years.
