Albert E. Rozendaal, 90, passed away on July 11, 1997, at the Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines, Iowa.

Funeral services were held Monday, July 14 at the First Reformed Church in Sully. Officiating were Pastor Roger Punt and Pastor Brice Hoyt. Organist was played by Linda Schnell.
