## Mrs. Helen Rust (Succumbs Sunday To Long Illness

Helen Proctor Rust died Sunday morning at a local hospital where she had been a patient for the past year.

Graveside services were held this afternoon (Monday) at Hazelwood cemetery with the Rev. Robert Dewey and the Rev. Ralph Beebe officiating. James-Schalinske Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Frederick D. and Carrie Preston Proctor, she was born Nov. 7th, 1886, in Grinnell. She grew up here, attending the local schools and graduating from Grinnell high school.
