

Rutherford memorial set

Jane Matlack Rutherford, 78, of 802 Park St., Grinnell, died Monday, Dec. 12, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

She willed her body to the University of Iowa Medical School. A memorial service will be conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday at the United Church of Christ-Congregational, with the Rev. David Bowman officiating.

The family requests that donations in her name be made to The Second Mile or to the United Church of Christ-Congregational.

She was born June 10, 1910, in Grinnell, the daughter of Henry William and Merta Johnson Matlack. She attended Grinnell public schools and Grinnell College.

She was married to M/Sgt. James C. Rutherford in 1947. While he was stationed with the 12th Army Regiment at Geinhausen, she served as president of the NCO Wives Club. She also organized the American and German Youth Alliance and helped establish their clubhouse.

Upon returning to the U.S., she again served in the NCO Wives Club while her husband stationed at West Point. She returned to Grinnell in 1957.

Mrs. Rutherford served as president of the Uncle Sam's Club board and as moderator of the United Church of Christ-Congregational. She was appointed to the Grinnell Area Housing Board and the Grinnell Low-Rent Housing Board.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; a brother, David; and a sister,
