Florence Sack, 76, of Pella, a native of Poweshiek County, died Sunday, March 18, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were held Wednesday at the Van Dyk-Duven Funeral Home in Pella, with the Rev. Ronald E. Cowles officiating. Burial was at Oakwood Cemetery in Pella.

The daughter of Marcus and Helen Reimers Ohland, she was born Jan. 6, 1903, near Newburg. She later taught in rural Poweshiek County schools for two years, after which she attended Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls. She taught for several years in the Pella elementary schools.

She was married to Harold Sack in the early 1930s. He preceded her in death in 1961.
