## Lynn Sampson

Lynn G. Sampson, 50, of Chicago, formerly of Grinnell, died Sunday, Jan. 19, at his home.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at the First Baptist Church in Grinnell, with the Rev. Cliff Bevins officiating. Organist was James Severe, and vocalist was Milton Severe. Pallbearers were Gail Latcham, John Latcham, Chuck Olson, Gregory Sampson, Jeffrey Sampson and Kirk Sampson.

Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Memorials in Mr. Sampson's name may be made to the First Baptist Church.

The son of Lynn and Mildred Olson Sampson, he was born May 8, 1941, in Barrington, Ill. He moved with his family to Grinnell in 1947 and graduated from Grinnell High School in 1959. He received a B.S. degree in journalism from the University of Iowa in 1964. Following his education he worked for the state of Illinois in the Department of Rehabilitation, and for the past 17 years he was supervisor of the department's Oak Park office.

He is survived by his mother, Mildred Sampson of Grinnell, and two brothers, John of Grinnell and Robert of Marshalltown. He was preceded in death by his father.
