Joel N. Sandven, Kellogg Resident, Succumbs Monday

Joel N. Sandven, 54, a resident of Kellogg for the past 22 years, died Monday afternoon at a Grinnell hospital.

Funeral services were held on Wednesday afternoon from the Kellogg Lutheran church with the Rev. David Burmaster, pastor, officiating. Interment was in Roland cemetery at Roland.

Born at Roland on March 17, 1912, he was the son of Jarjan and Carrie Sandven. He was educated in the Roland schools and attended Iowa State University.

On March 21, 1935, he was united in marriage with Edna Smith at Nevada. He is survived by his widow, Edna; a daughter, Mrs. Gail Osborn of Des Moines; and a grandson, Christopher K. Osborn, also of Des Moines.

Other survivors include a brother, Reuben Sandven of Dubuque; and three sisters, Mrs. Mark Giere of Mason City, Mrs. Esther Skarshaug of Northfield, Minn., and Mrs. Donald Rickey of Geneva, Ill.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two sisters, and a brother.

In 1944, he moved to Kellogg from Newton. In Kellogg, he operated a hardware store and bottle gas business.

He was a member of the Kellogg Lutheran church, Grinnell Elks Lodge, and the Izaak Walton League chapter at Newton.
