## Hubert Saxton rites Tuesday

Hubert E. Saxton, 71, of 1803 Third Ave., Grinnell, died early Saturday, Oct. 15, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at St. John's Lutheran Church, with the Rev. Marcus E. Reitz officiating. Burial will be at Hazelwood Cemetery.
