## Charles Schallau Rites Saturday

Charles C. Schallau, 83, a former Grinnell resident, passed away Sunday afternoon in Des Moines where he had been making his home.

The son of John and Maria Schallau, he was born near Van Horne, Ia., on Mar. 28, 1885. On Nov. 10, 1917, he was married to Gail Winifred Hevener at Nashua, Ia.
