Former Searsboro Resident Dies

Miss Anna Marie Schmidt, age 67, formerly of the Searsboro area, passed away Tuesday morning at an Oskaloosa nursing home.

She was born November 16, 1899, near Searsboro, the daughter of William F. and Amelia Mader Schmidt. She attended the country schools near Bluepoint, and later graduated from Grinnell High with the class of 1918. She had been baptized and confirmed in the Catholic faith, and had attended St. Columbanus church in Grinnell, many years ago. She had led a confined life when her health failed some 50 years ago. She is survived by her brother, Fred Schmidt of Grinnell, and several cousins. She was preceded in death by her parents.

Funeral services for Miss Anna Marie Schmidt were held at 9:30 this (Thursday) morning at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Leo V. Kuebrich, pastor of St. Mary's Catholic church, officiating.
