

## Verle Scribner rites Tuesday

Verle Scribner, 67, of 1124 Prince St. died of a heart ailment Friday, Sept. 15, at Bemidji Hospital in Bemidji, Minn.

The Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at St. Mary's Catholic Church here, with the Rev. Harry Linnenbrink officiating. Burial will be at Hazelwood Cemetery.
