

L. O. Scull Dies, Longtime Resident Of Lynnville Area

L. O. Scull, 82, resident of Lynnville for many years, died Monday afternoon at an Iowa City hospital where he had been a patient for more than two weeks.

A retired farmer and former Lynnville marshal, Mr. Scull moved to the Lynnville area with his parents when a child. He was born Feb. 4th, 1876, at Troy Mills.

His wife preceded him in death in 1950. Mr. Scull is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Harry Savage of Des Moines and Mrs. Millard Sparks of Lynnville; three sons, Louis, Reno, and Robert, all of Lynnville; 13 grandchildren, and nine great grandchildren.

He was a 50 year member of the Masons.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Thursday) from the Lynnville Friends church with the Rev. Carl D. Byrd officiating. Music was furnished by a quartet composed of Mrs. Ozro Dearing, Mrs. Harvey Gause, Warren Stanley, and Homer McDowell.
